Introduction

In an effort to prevent the spread of infectious diseases and to promote the health of our employees and their families, Levingston has developed a Temporary Screening Plan. This plan will be utilized as called for by Levingston's Infectious Disease Preparedness and Response Plan.

Purpose

The purpose of this plan is to provide guidance on how to implement temporary employee and visitor screening at the Levingston office site in the event it is deemed necessary.

Scope

This plan will cover the following topics as related to visitor and employees assigned to the 210 Teal and 219 Teal office buildings:

- Visitor Screening
- Employee Screening
- Screening Questionnaire

Visitor Screening

During times when Levingston Senior Management classifies the level of community transmission or impact of infectious disease (i.e. COVID-19) for Calcasieu Parish as "Minimal" or higher, according to the recommendations published by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), all visitors will be screened prior to being allowed entry into Levingston facilities. The following screening activities will be required:

- All visitors will require an appointment prior to arrival at premises
- All visitors will be directed to the 210 lobby and receptionist
- Unscheduled visitors will be asked to leave the premises and schedule an appointment
- All visitors will be asked to complete a Screening Questionnaire with temperature measurement
- Based on the visitor's answers, entry rights will be determined

Employee Screening

During times when Levingston Senior Management classifies the level of community transmission or impact of infectious disease (i.e. COVID-19) for Calcasieu Parish as "Moderate" or higher, according to the recommendations published by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), all employees will be screen prior to being allowed entry into Levingston facilities. The following screening activities will be required:

- All employees will enter all facilities via the 210 lobby and receptionist
- All employees will be asked to answer a Screening Questionnaire with temperature measurement
- Based on the employees' answers, entry rights will be determined
